Future City Engineering provides students with an opportunity to develop a city of the future. They will build an online design for the city (using Sim City 5, provided), build a table-top sized 3-D model of the city, write essays about their future city designs/plans, and give a formal presentation in front of a panel of judges.

Students are required to have an Engineer Mentor who works with the team weekly, and it would be extremely helpful if there was a Parent Host willing to sponsor these weekly meetings.

Teams are encouraged to locate area engineers willing to work with their team. (The Engineer Mentor may be the same person as the Parent Host).

You will be placed on a Future City Engineering team if humanly possible! If you have specific students with whom you'd like to work, please list them below.

NOTE: **ONLY THREE STUDENTS** are allowed to be official presenters on any Future City Engineering team, no matter how large your team becomes. It is important to note that if the team advances to Nationals, only those three students per team will be funded for free travel to Washington, D.C., from the official sponsors. Others on the team will need to have expenses paid by team fundraising efforts. Team members will need to consider this issue as they configure their teams.
